The One Hope Project is a ministry of churches in the Coachella Valley working together with ministry organizations to provide Bibles to persecuted Christians.

Since 2008, over \$405,000 has been raised to cover the costs of nearly 210,000 Bibles to people in persecuted countries!

HELP SPREAD HOPE: PROVIDE BIBLES TO THE PERSECUTED CHURCH



The One Hope Project, a collaborative initiative involving churches, individuals, and various organizations in the Coachella Valley, gathered in November 2024. Their purpose was to pray for persecuted Christians globally and contribute donations for supplying them with Bibles. The total donations for 2024 exceeded \$36,000, which covered the costs of over 145,000 Bible keychains to individuals in persecuted regions.

There are over 360 million Christians residing in parts of the world where they face persecution due to their faith.

The One Hope Project is committed to ensuring that every persecuted Christian receives a Bible. In 2024, the funds were sent to Frontlines International, an organization that distributes Bibles to persecuted Christians.

Since the project's start in 2008, the One Hope Project has raised over \$405,000, which covered the cost of nearly 210,000 Bibles.
